

# Homework Timetable 2016-2017

## At Key Stage 3

- It is reasonable to expect students to spend 30 minutes to 1 hour on each homework task per fortnight for Science, and weekly for English, Mathematics and Languages (French and/or German or Spanish).
- The following subjects: Art & Design, Design Technology, Geography, History, ICT and Religious Studies, set 'Independent Learning Tasks'. These are calendared with one task per week and should take a minimum of 2 hours. (see Page 2)
- Music and Physical Education do not set homework, although both are happy to provide resources and access to extra-curricular activities for those who wish to develop their skills.

## At Key Stage 4

- Students should expect homework tasks lasting 30 minutes to 1 hour according to their subjects.
- English set homework weekly. Mathematics and Science set homework at least once per fortnight.
- Most option subjects set homework regularly at specific points during the course, either on a weekly or fortnightly basis. (See Page 3)

## At Key Stage 5

Students should expect a variety of homework and independent learning tasks across all of their subjects. It is highly likely that this will equate to at least three hours per subject, per week. As part of their individual 16-19 study programme, students will be given directed private study periods across their timetable. It is an expectation of our Sixth Form that students use their study periods to full effect by supplementing their classwork and completing and organising their homework/coursework tasks. A further expectation is that any work not completed as part of their directed private study is completed at home and that all deadlines are met in every subject area.
