GIRLS - YEARS 7 TO 11

Every article of clothing must be plainly and permanently marked with the owner's name:

Navy blue blazer with **Bournside* badge

Bournside* school tie (green and blue stripes plus Year colour) **For Year 7 2017 the stripe will be yellow

**Bournside* navy pleated skirt with Bournside badge on left hip. The hem of the skirt must touch the knee and the badge be clearly visible

**Bournside* navy, full length tailored trousers with Bournside badge on left hip

White shirt, regular or fitted - must button at the neck. Short shirt-style sleeves are allowed, but not cap sleeves

Navy blue V-necked pullover

Navy ankle socks, navy 3/4 socks, navy, black or natural-coloured plain tights

Black or dark brown leather shoes, plain style, low heel (no platforms, boots or trainers)

Green or navy blue apron for **Technology**

Physical Education

Compulsory

**Bournside* white polo shirt with Bournside badge

Navy blue 'skort'

**Bournside* Emerald green hockey socks

White short sport socks

Predominantly white lace up trainers

Shin pads

**Bournside* Micro fleece half zip top with Bournside badge and white piping

Navy tracksuit bottoms

**Bournside* white base-layer

**Bournside* Navy blue hooded top with Bournside badge- for after school sports only

**Bournside* Sport polo shirt- for after school sports only

**Bournside* GCSE PE Polo shirt (Key Stage 4 only) for indoor PE lessons

BOYS - YEARS 7 TO 11

Every article of clothing must be plainly and permanently marked with the owner's name:

Navy blue blazer with **Bournside* badge

Bournside* school tie (green and blue stripes plus Year colour). **For Year 7 2017 the stripe will be yellow

**Bournside* black, full length tailored trousers with Bournside badge on left hip

Dark socks

White plain shirt with long or short sleeves

Navy blue V-necked pullover

Plain black or dark brown leather shoes of conventional pattern (not boots or trainers)

Green or navy blue apron for Technology

**Bournside* white polo shirt with Bournside badge

Navy blue shorts

**Bournside* rugby/football top –navy/green fully reversible.

**Bournside* Emerald green rugby/football socks

Rugby/Football boots. It should be noted that studs of the screw-in type must conform to the safety standards set by the Rugby Football Union.
