An Introduction to Activities Week 2025



I am excited to launch Activities Week 2025 on behalf of everyone involved at Bournside. Now in its third year, we have revised the Activities Week programme offer, taking into account valuable student and parent/carer feedback.

Key changes to this year's Activities Week include:

- **Activities Week is for ALL students in Key Stage 3 (Years 7, 8 and 9).**
- Activities Week. We have simplified the week into a week long **'Package A'** or **'Package B'** system.
- Students are **split by year groups**, rather than by House, bringing friendship groups together.
- On Monday 14th July, all students will be off timetable but in school.
- From Tuesday 15th to Thursday 17th July students will go on three days of external trips, relevant to the Package they have selected.
- **A £15 deposit is required for Package A. A £40 deposit is required for Package B.** The deposit deadline is **Wednesday 1st January 2025.** Payments should be made via MCAS (please see the 'Trips' tab).
- Students in Year 10 and Year 12 will carry out valuable work experience placements. Please follow the guidance sent from Mrs Martin. The expectation is that all Year 10 or Year 12 will either be on an organised school trip OR be on work experience during Activities Week.

As well as the Activities Week Packages in this guide, students have the opportunity to join extended residential trips during the week. These range from the **Year 9 Camp in the Mendips** and adventurous activities in the **Dordogne, France** and the **Brecon Beacons**, to exploring **France, Belgium, and Germany**. Plus, the welcome return of our Sports Tour, this time to **South Africa!**

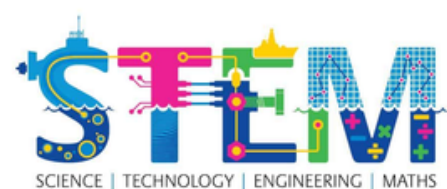

Year 7 will be carrying out a host of exciting Maths and computing challenges with a host of local employers. They will have a challenging but fun filled day.



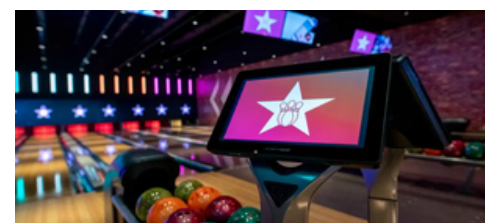
We the Curious - Package A + B

A Design & Technology led trip to Legoland with links to Science. Students will attend a hands-on workshop and have time to enjoy the rides too including the new Speedway ride!



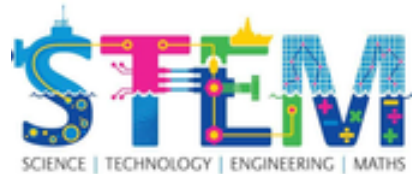

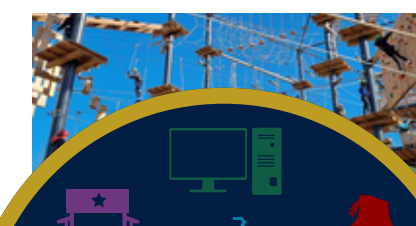
Black Country Museum - Package B

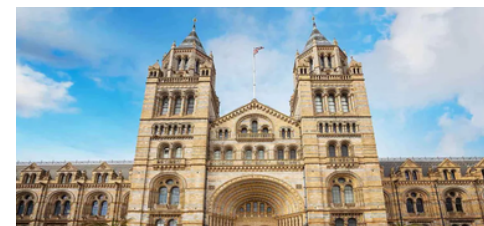
Business & Enterprise Day - Package A + B

Information and booking conditions

- Activities Week will take place from Monday 14th July until Friday 18th July 2025. Friday the 18th July will be our Sports Day and last day of term.
- All students in Year 7, 8 and 9 will take part in Activities Week.
- Students in Year 10 and 12 complete Work Experience during Activities Week (information to follow).
- All students must select one Year Group Package (either A or B). This will include three trips taking place on Tuesday 15th, Wednesday 16th and Thursday 17th July 2025. This year, you will not select individual trips. Each Package will contain all your child's trips. These set trips are included in the total Package cost.
- A £15 deposit is required for Package A. A £40 deposit is required for Package B. The deposit deadline is Wednesday 1st January 2025. Payments should be made via MCAS (please see the 'Trips' tab).
- There will be a first come, first serve policy for spaces on each Package. In the event of a Year group Package being sold out, you can request to join a waiting list.
- Whilst every effort has been made to provide an accurate description of the proposed trips, some venues are not able to take bookings this far in advance. Therefore, we may need to change the provider/venue if they are unable to provide what we require. We will make every effort to book an alternative as near as possible to the original offer.
- Students who do not sign up for a trip Package by the deposit deadline on Wednesday 1st January 2025 will be allocated school-based activities that explore different areas of the curriculum. We would like all students to select fun Package choices as a first priority to ensure they have the best, fun-filled week! We have considered the price of our two Packages, so there is a more affordable option for each year group.
- There is financial support of £30 per student eligible for Pupil Premium funding. Unfortunately, financial assistance will not be available to any other students.
- Packages require a minimum number of pupils to run. In the event of a Package not being viable due to pupils numbers, it may be replaced or removed. Parents/carers will be notified.
- We have tried to cost Packages as accurately as possible, however prices and transport costs may change, so costs may vary slightly. Should the final cost exceed the amount advertised by more than £10, Parents/carers will be contacted to discuss the option of meeting the increased cost or agreeing to an alternative Package.
- Once places have been confirmed it will not be possible for pupils to swap Packages. Any queries regarding Packages or anything Activities Week related must be made via email to activitiesweek@bournside.gloucs.sch.uk.
- All activities must be paid in full via MyChildatSchool (MCAS) by Monday 3rd March 2025. If full payment has not been made by this date, your child's place will be withdrawn without refund of monies paid. This payment deadline is separate for extended residentials - Y9 Camp, Dordogne, France (Y9, 10, 11 & 12), DofE to Beacon, Wales (Y12), Germany (Y8/9), Battlefields in Belgium (Y8/9) and South Africa (Y10/11). Please note, there is a different payment schedule for these extended residential trips. Please see individual trip communications for details.
