My name is Dr Adam Jakes, a medical registrar working in central London with my colleague Benjamin Allison, a final year medical student at King's College London.


We are acutely aware of the disruption that COVID-19 has caused to everyone and in relation to this email specifically, the ability to obtain clinical work experience for prospective medical school applicants. Considering this, we have created an online medical work experience webinar. We aim to make this an interactive experience where students can learn about the life of a doctor from the safety of their homes. We will be covering several topics including medicine, surgery, night shifts, work-life balance and hot topics. We will also be introducing skills such as history taking, clinical examination, use of a stethoscope and ECG interpretation.

Furthermore, we will be hosting a Q&A session at the end to give students the chance to speak directly to junior doctors and get all their queries answered.

We are hosting our first webinar on **19**th **July 2021 6pm – 8pm**, so this will be perfect for both students who have already applied to strengthen their experience for interviews and those who are thinking about applying in 2021.

There is a cost of £25 per person, which will cover the cost of staff, a certificate of attendance and access to a WhatsApp group for ongoing support.

Pathways to Property Summer School - Last Chance for Year 12 students to apply

Pathways to Property, at Henley Business School, University of Reading is a charity-funded initiative launched to raise awareness of and aspirations about the vast range of careers within the property sector. Pathways to Property is hosting its ninth Summer School for Year 12 students from 19 – 21st July and applications are closing soon (30th June) so it is the last chance for your students to apply.

The Summer School is a fully funded, 3-day online programme for Year 12 students. During the week, students will attend taster lectures, experience online site visits, take part in a group project and debate and learn to network with key employers in the industry. At the end of the week, if they are keen to learn more about property they can complete a **funded work experience placement** over October half term, have access to our **e-mentoring programme**, and if they choose to study a property related degree, can **apply for a bursary of up to £30,000 over three years**.

To date, over 700 students have attended the Summer School and 24% of these have chosen to pursue a career in property – either through studying a property related degree at University or completing a property related apprenticeship.

APPLICATIONS FOR THE SUMMER SCHOOL ARE CLOSING ON 30th JUNE. The 2021 Summer School will take place from 19-21 July and will be held online due to COVID-19 restrictions. Apply here

Students who are too young to join our Summer School can instead join our **OOC** (**Open Online Course**). The OOC is a three week, free, online course designed by leading academics at Henley Business School to excite young people about a career in property and signpost them to resources that can support them while making the step into the industry. This course is designed for students in Year 9 and upwards and can be completed in their own time, requiring only 6 hours of study. This course has started and will run throughout the year. Join here
