





The Cardiac Physiology Service provides a broad range of diagnostic tests and treatments to adult patients. The Apprentice will be expected to complete the elements of the Healthcare Science Practitioner (Cardiac Physiology) apprenticeship Level 6 over a 3 year timeframe. The timeframe includes:
