- discuss with your tutor in advance if you need to be absent for a good reason
- be in and stay in school from 8:45 am until 3:10 pm every day
- use the signing in/out system correctly if there is a reason you need to leave site
- use your private study time in school responsibly, making best use of the resources in the Sixth Form and Learning Centres
- complete all homework and coursework assignments to the best of your ability and by the required deadline
- comply with all school rules, including our Sixth Form Dress Code
- respect the rights of all members of the school and surrounding community
- respect the Centre and its resources so that everyone can work in a calm, clean and cooperative environment.
