I am writing to inform you of an event that might interest your sixth form students who are thinking of applying to study medicine. Long Road Sixth Form College in Cambridge are hosting the 'Getting Into Medical School Workshop' in collaboration with In2Med on Saturday 10th of July at 10:00am – 1pm. This virtual workshop is free of charge and is designed to help students in their application for medical school. This event is aimed at year 11 and year 12 students ideally, but if you know of any other students who would be interested in coming then they are more than welcome to join.

There will be a variety of speakers including medical students, junior doctors recently graduated from the University Cambridge and teachers from across the country covering a range of topics about applying to medical school.
