

## **UK Polar Network Antarctica Day Flag Competition**



Geography pupils had the opportunity to create inspirational flags 'in the interest of all mankind' as part of the UK Polar Network Antarctica Day Flag Competition. Four flags were selected to be used together to create the school's submission.

Fantastically, the design was selected as a winner and taken to Halley Research Station, Antarctica by IT Engineer, Martin Steel (pictured). Here scientists study global issues from climate change and rising sea levels to the ozone hole.

Congratulations to the artists Evie Midwinter (Year 9), Hannah Mortimer (Year 7), Rosie Janta-Lipinski (Year 9) and Emily Furley (Year 9) on their winning designs.
