#### Testing reminder

In view of the increasing numbers of Covid cases in the Cheltenham area please can we remind you of the importance of regularly testing using the lateral flow tests provided by the school. We have now had several confirmed cases in school which has meant that we have had to ask student groups to isolate and, in two cases, entire year group bubbles. We ask that we all continue to be vigilant with following the Public Health England rules.
