# **Mobile technology policy**

This week we started our 'engage' phase of our new mobile technology policy. During this phase, if a student is using their mobile device on school site without the permission and direct supervision of a member of staff their device has been confiscated and students have been allowed to collect their device at the end of the school day from student reception. We are thrilled to report nearly of all our school community have responded brilliantly to this and we have seen a noticeable decrease of mobile technology around the site, especially during social time; students are talking to each other more as opposed to staring at screens which is very pleasing to see. We thank all the parents/carers who are supporting the school with this new and remind you that this phase will continue until Friday 21st May.

From Monday 24th May, we will enter the final phase of the transition to our new policy. We are calling this our 'enforce' phase. From this point onwards any student using their mobile device not in line with the new policy will have their device confiscated and a parent/carer will be asked to collect it on their behalf at the end of the school or when they are willing and

able. We very much appreciate your support in this matter and ask that you continue discuss this with your child.

## Year 11 Prom

It is very much our hope that we can host a year 11 Prom to mark the end of what has been an important and challenging year for all our year 11 students. Earlier in the year the possibility of hosting such an event was very much in doubt. #### Uniform, Equipment and PE kit - Term 5

We recognise the challenges that we have all faced throughout the latest period of lockdown and have made reasonable adjustments for those students who have grown out of uniform, who have been unable to get school shoes or who have misplaced key pieces of equipment. However, with a new term starting and shops scheduled to reopen on the 12th April, we ask for your support in ensuring that your child returns to school adhering to our school uniform and equipment expectations, which can be found here. In particular, we ask for your support with 3 areas:

- 1. School shoes: All students are expected to wear plain black or dark brown shoes with a low heel platforms, boots, trainers, and ballet pumps without a hard-based soles are not permitted.
- 2. Learning equipment: we expect all students to arrive at school every day with the necessary equipment to allow them to have a successful day of learning. Compulsory items include:
  - Appropriate rucksack-style school bag (not a handbag)
  - A pencil case
  - Our magnificent 7 (can be purchased at school):
    - o 2 pens, 2 pencils, a ruler, an eraser, a pencil sharpener
  - Reading book
  - Planner
  - Calculator
  - Drink bottle
  - Helmet if cycling to school
