counties and is judged by 15 professional adjudicators.


Our talented students took part in all sections of the competition and came away placing in multiple categories along with gaining trophies for having the highest marks.

School updates

Year 7 & 8 assessments

You will have seen from the school calendar that year 7 & 8 have assessments in the weeks outlined below. These are not formal examstyle assessments. There is no timetable; they will take place in normal lessons during the time period outlined. Students will be briefed by their teachers about their assessments and how to prepare for them. The results will be used to inform their R3 reports which will be published during Term 6.

- Year 7 Monday 6th June to Friday 17th June; R3 published Friday 8th July
- Year 8 Monday 23rd May to Friday 27th May and Monday 6th June to Friday 10th June; R3 published Friday 1st July
- Year 9 Monday 16th May to Friday 27th May; R3 published Friday 24th June

Changes to Lunch arrangements for students - during the exam season, from Monday 16th May to Friday 10th June

To accommodate the GCSE exams that take place during this school period, ahead of Year 11 study leave commencing on Monday 13th June, there are some changes to the lunch arrangements for students.

For this three-week period, Year 9 will have lunch P4b (and their P4b lessons will be taught P4a) and Year 11 will have lunch P4a (and their P4a lessons will be taught P4b).

Year 9 will have their lunch in the Upper Dining Centre.

Year 11 will have their lunch in the Lower Dining Centre.

Year 7 will have lunch at the same time (P4a) but in the Upper Dining Centre.

Students have been made aware of this change.

Year 11 prom

Year 11 prom tickets are now on sale and can be purchased through the MyChildAtSchool app. Please be aware that the deadline for purchasing tickets is Sunday 5th June.

The Prom will be held in the Gold Cup Suite at Cheltenham Racecourse on Thursday 7th July. Students are welcome to arrive in style from 6.30pm for a 7pm start. Carriages need to be ready and waiting for the collection of students by 11pm.

The cost of the Prom ticket is £40 and includes:

- The hiring of the venue with an onsite Prom host and security personnel
- Private coat and wardrobe area
- The hiring of a DJ and Disco
- Table and room decorations
- · Welcome drink on arrival
- 3-course hot buffet-style dinner (final menu to be decided)

We hope that all students can attend the Prom, and as such, if there are any financial hardships that you face such that you require assistance in purchasing a ticket for your child, we will endeavour to help. If this assistance is required please contact the student's Head of House.

Please note that the invitation to the prom will be withdrawn for any student whose behaviour, at any time, falls short of the values and expectations of the school.
