Students success in international maths challenge



Congratulations to the 53 Year 7 and 8 students who achieved certificates in the Junior Maths Challenge, run by the [United Kingdom Mathematics Trust](#).



The challenge tests their mathematical reasoning, precision of thought and fluency through complex mathematical problems. To recognise the highest performers the top-scoring 50% of participants received bronze, silver and gold certificates in the ratio of 3:2:1.



Four students gained Gold Awards, seventeen students gained Silver Awards and thirty-two gained Bronze Awards!

Mr Mumford, teacher of mathematics, said "Huge congratulations to every student that chose to take part this year. To achieve a gold, silver or bronze certificate in this challenge is testament to their incredible problem-solving skills. The students below should be immensely proud of themselves."

GCSE examinations

- On Monday 13th June, study leave commences. We would encourage students to continue to access sessions as per the programme from this point onwards.
- Warmups for examinations will continue at 8:00am and 1:00pm throughout the exam season.

Year 10 science support programmes

Based on recent performance in year 10 examinations, we will be sending letters home to students if that support work is compulsory. Students who complete the assignments will be rewarded with house points - with prizes for the students who complete the most support work during term 6.

We hope that you can see we understand that many students have suffered significant disruption during COVID and hope that this early support will allow students to increase in both confidence and knowledge, allowing for greater success next year.
