Reminder: New Parent Portal coming at Easter

A reminder that during the Easter holidays the school will be moving across to a new Management Information System called Bromcom.

We will be discontinuing the use of SchoolGateway today at 2.30pm. You will not be able to access SchoolGateway to make payments after this time. All remaining balances will be transferred across to the new MyChildatSchool [MCAS] Parent Portal.

Next steps:

- To login to the **MyChildatSchool [MCAS] Parent Portal** you will need to have a valid email address registered with the school and an Invitation Code which we will send to you on Wednesday 20th April.
- We recommend downloading the **MCAS** app (and allowing push notifications), but you can also access **MCAS** from within your web browser at www.mychildatschool.com
