## School updates continued ...

#### **Ukraine fundraising - Friday 25th March**



Throughout this week and next, students will have either had or will be having an assembly about the war in Ukraine. As a school, we would like to raise money and collect essential items to support the relief and aid effort. Therefore, on Friday 25th March we will be holding a fundraising and awareness day.

As part of this students and staff are being asked to supplement their uniform with blue and yellow. This is not a non-school uniform day and school blazers are expected to be worn. However, students

can don the colours of the Ukrainian flag by exchanging or supplementing items of their uniform. They could; change their shirt or trouser colour to yellow or blue, wear wacky socks, wear a hat or scarf, add some yellow or blue make-up, wear a different tie or generally accessorise their uniform with blue and yellow items.

We ask that a minimum £1 donation is made by all students at their House gates in the morning. Additionally, if you would like to further donations you can do so via School Gateway or contribute directly to the <a href="Red Cross: Ukrainian Appeal">Red Cross: Ukrainian Appeal</a>

We will also be holding a collection of essential items and will be working with a local charity to ensure delivery to areas where they are needed. If you would like to donate any items please can they be from the following list only:

There will also be a variety of other activities in tutor time and throughout the day to raise awareness amongst our students.
