Over the Easter break we successfully transitioned to a new Management Information System called Bromcom. Part of this new system is the My Child at School (MCAS) parent portal and app, which we are now using instead of the School Gateway.

We would like to thank all our parents for their patience during this transition and hopefully we have now ironed out any teething issues which a few of our parents may have experienced this week. As a reminder, please note that parents/guardians of students at Cheltenham Bournside School will should use MyChildAtSchool (MCAS) to:

- Top up dining centre balances and make payments for trips and other purchases
- Send messages to the school to report a child's absence
- Update personal details for themselves or their children

The app is very simple to use, you will be able to find two quick 'how to' guides for <u>reporting your child's absence and providing payments</u> and topping up dinner money balances here.
