Students were invited to translate the tombstones and altars in the Roman Baths and were able to handle some amazing artefacts related to daily life in the Baths - including 2000-year-old terracotta!



During a tour of the Baths, the students stopped to speak with a 'Roman Lady', an actor who she shared how she got her hair and make-up ready.

Mrs Avila, Teacher of Modern Foreign Languages, said, "The trip to the Roman Baths was great, the students all really enjoyed it. The Roman Baths complex is part of the GCSE curriculum, so it was fantastic to be able to learn about it hands on and to bring the subject to life.
