Congratulations to Oliver Belbeck for his fantastic performance in the England Athletics Under 15 boys' octathlon at the Bedford International Stadium last weekend, taking overall Silver. His efforts across eight athletics disciplines secured him 2nd place in the UK and 1st place in England.

Representing Cheltenham & County Harriers, Oliver, Year 9, Frank House, won the High Jump, clearing 1.59, and placed second in both the

javelin throw and 400m in the competition.
